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Vaccine Requirements for Students Entering 6th Grade for 2022-2023 Sport Physical Requirement

May, 2022

Dear Parents of Incoming 6th Grade Students:

I hope this letter finds you and your family doing well.

The State of NJ requires all incoming 6th grade students to have the two below immunizations by the start of the upcoming 2022-2023 school year.

1. Tdap: Booster immunization for diphtheria, tetanus, and whooping cough.
2. Initial Vaccine for Meningococcal Meningitis. *(Given to students when they turn 11, so if your child has a later birthday, your healthcare provider may choose to wait to give it to them on or right after their birthday)

Additionally, if your child wishes to try out for a school fall sport, he/she will need a current physical from their health care provider, on the State Provided Sport Physical Packets. These Packets are available for you to print out from the school website under news and events, or in my office.

***All physicals must be less than one year old from the first day or tryouts or practice.**

We understand it may take time to get an appointment with your child's health care provider for the required immunizations and/ or physical, so we wanted to give you ample time to schedule an appointment before the start of the September school year. All physicals must be handed in and complete PRIOR to any student starting or trying out for any school sport. Additionally, the required vaccines are due by the start of the September 2022 school year.

You may mail the paperwork to the school with attention to Mrs. Looney/Nurse, or your provider may fax documents to the school at 732-528-0810 at your request. You may also drop them off to the school during school hours.
