**\*Notes**

Testing mode refers to how the student will be administered the assessment. Some computer-based assessments allow students to take the assessment using paper and pencil. Be sure to inquire about the options if your son/daughter has a medical issue that would not allow him/her to take the assessment on the computer.

'Duration' is the maximum amount of testing time allotted to students to complete the assessment. Most students finish well in advance of the allotted time.

The testing window is the period in which districts administer the assessment, not the actual number of days it takes a student to test. School districts can choose which days within the testing windows that it wants to assess students. Whenever possible we have tried to show specific dates. You may enquire with your child's teacher about the exact dates.

Results window indicates when the reports will be available to the district. The district will send out reports to parents as soon as possible. Please contact the district for further information.
