Dear Brielle Families:

We have been actively working to prepare for the possibility of a health-related school closure in light of the impact of the Coronavirus on nearby communities.

With much consideration for current health concerns, the following decisions have been made with the best interest of our children, teachers, staff, parents and community in mind:

The performance dates for *Seussical The Musical* have been rescheduled for Saturday, March 14th. Show times are 3:00pm and 7:00pm. A special dress rehearsal is scheduled for Friday, March 13, at 1:30pm for Brielle students.

The Super Heroes Blazer Boys night scheduled for Friday, March 13th, has been postponed. Due to the nature of this event, an outside vendor was scheduled to supply "equipment" for the children to enjoy.

The Brielle School District reserves the right to suspend school operations at its own discretion should we believe it is necessary, in which case the school calendar will be adjusted accordingly as those days will not be counted. In the event of a school closure, the public will be informed using our school's normal communication methods which includes calls from our Honeywell Instant Alert system, our website at www.brielleschool.org and school social media accounts.

Moving forward, we will be evaluating whether or not to cancel field trips on a case-by-case basis. If cancellation for a health-related issue, all expenses paid to the school by parents will be fully reimbursed.

The health and safety of our students and staff is our biggest priority. In support of the larger public health effort, we encourage students or teachers experiencing symptoms of cold, flu, or other contagious diseases, to stay home from school and be evaluated by a medical professional.
